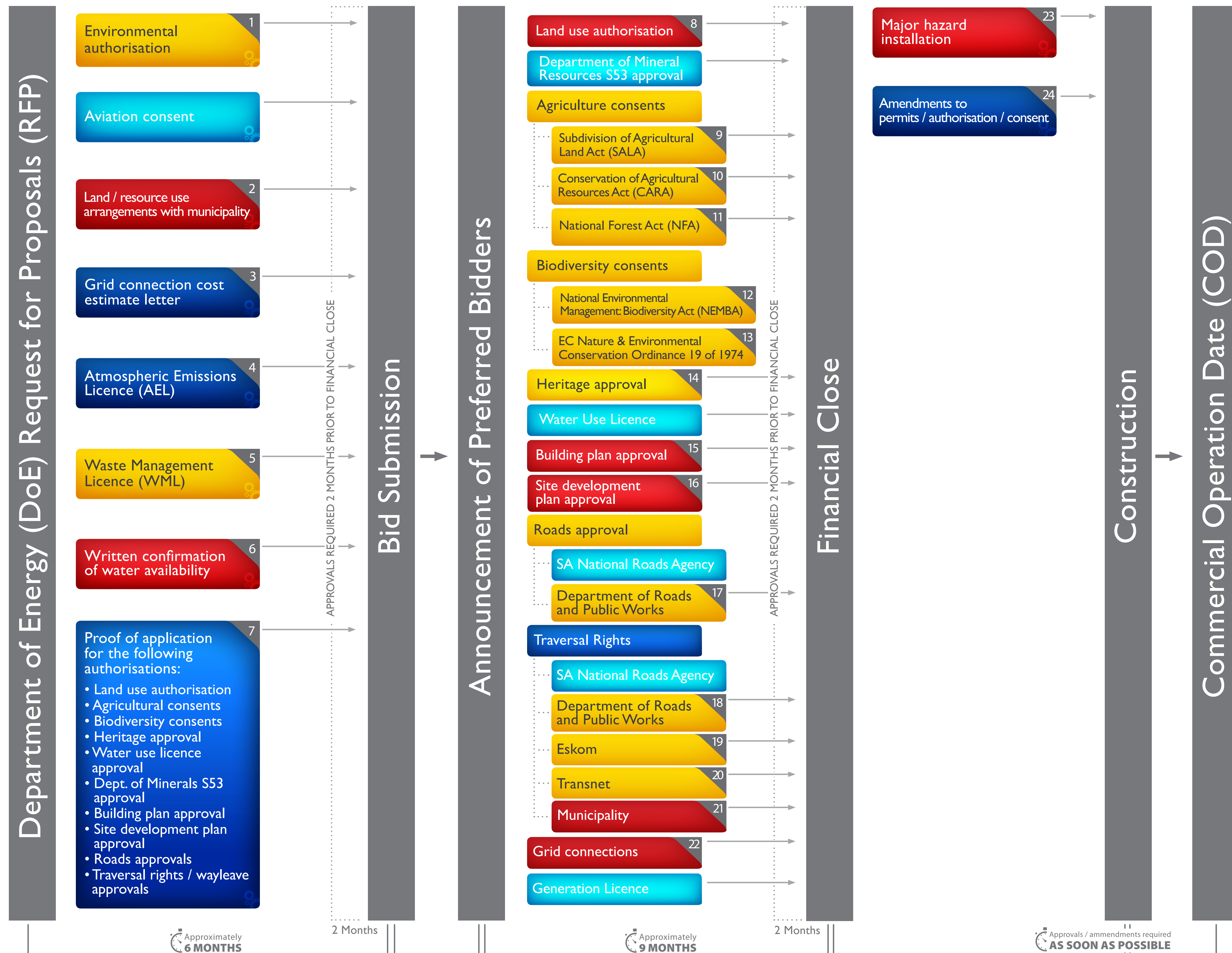


Renewable Energy Independent Power Producer Procurement Programme (REI4P)

Permitting and Authorisation Processes

Role of Provincial and Municipal Government

- DEDEAT to follow up on progress of applications.
- Metropolitan / local municipality to enter into agreement with private developer for a specific project.
- Metropolitan / local municipality to issue a cost estimation letter for the generation facility to connect into the municipal grid.
- Metropolitan / district municipality or DEDEAT to issue a licence subsequent to a positive ROD from DEA.
- DEDEAT to issue a licence subsequent to a positive ROD from DEA.
- Metropolitan / local municipality / Water Services Provider to provide confirmation of water availability for the project on request from developer.
- Municipalities, DRDAR, DEDEAT, ECPHRA and DRPW to confirm receipt of application.
- Metropolitan / local municipality receives application and
 - advertises application
 - receives and responds to objections
 - submits a recommendation / item to council
 - council takes a decision
 - application rejected / land use rights awarded
- DAFF and municipalities to clarify exactly where in the process they require the approval. DRDAR to act as liaison between national DAFF and municipalities. DRDAR to ensure that they place the SALA applications on the agenda of DAFF for prompt approval.
- DRDAR to ensure that they place the CARA applications on the agenda of DAFF for prompt approval.
- DEDEAT to ensure that they place the NFA applications on the agenda of DAFF for prompt approval.
- DEDEAT to receive, process and issue approvals in terms of the NEMBA.
- DEDEAT to receive, process and issue approvals in terms of the EC Nature and Environmental Conservation Ordinance 19 of 1974.
- ECPHRA to advise applicants on the level of assessment required. ECPHRA to receive, process and respond to applications, or submit them to national SAHRA in cases where heritage resources is of national importance.
- Metropolitan / local municipalities to review and approve building plans prior to financial close, with the approval of potential amendments subsequent to financial close.
- Metropolitan / local municipalities to review and approve site development plans prior to financial close, with the approval of potential amendments subsequent to financial close.
- DRPW receive and approve applications for proposed road works.
- DRPW receive and approve applications for traversal rights / wayleaves.
- DEDEAT to facilitate the approval of traversal rights / wayleaves by Transnet through the Eastern Cape - Transnet Joint Structures.
- Metropolitan / local municipalities receive and approve applications for traversal rights / wayleaves.
- Metropolitan / local municipalities to work with developers to ensure successful connection of generation facilities into the municipal grid. DEDEAT to facilitate connection into the Eskom grid through the Provincial Energy Forum and the Eastern Cape-Department of Public Enterprises Joint Structures.
- DEDEAT to facilitate the granting of traversal rights / wayleaves through the provincial energy forum and the Eastern Cape-Department of Public Enterprises Joint Structures.
- Metropolitan / local municipalities to provide comment on notification of major hazard installation by a developer.
- Metropolitan / local municipalities, DEDEAT, DRDAR, DRPW and ECPHRA to deal with approvals of amendments timeously



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
